
The PARTIES, having discussed the fields of common research interests and allied activities between the two institutions, have decided to enter into a long-term collaboration in the areas of education, training and research.

If the force majeure conditions continued beyond six months, the parties shall then mutually decide about the future course of action.

Any disputes arising out of this MoU shall be settled amicably through negotiations in good faith failing which the same shall be referred to and settled in accordance with the provisions of Arbitration & Conciliation Act, 1996 or any amendment thereof.
