DEPARTMENT OF PHYSICS UGC Sponsored National Seminar 'Energy Crisis- Causes, Effects and Solutions' on 13-14 August 2015 A REPORT

Indeed, it was a pleasure organizing the UGC sponsored National Seminar 'Energy Crisis- Causes, Effects and Solutions' on 13-14 August 2015.

The seminar was inaugurated by the Chief Guest of the inaugural session, Emeritus Scientist and Hon. Vice-Chancellor of D. Y. Patil University, Kolhapur Prof. S. H. Pawar. He released the souvenir on the occasion and was very happy to note that the souvenir was dedicated to Bharat Ratna, Dr. A. P. J. Abdul Kalam. In his inaugural address he congratulated the Department of Physics for having chosen a very relevant topic of national and international interest for the seminar. Later, in his highly energetic and motivating key note address titled 'Energy Nanotech @rand Challenges for Clean Environment' Prof. Pawar stressed on the need to invent new technologies such as nanotech to harness the solar energy to the maximum extent. Shri R. D. Shanbhag, Chairman, S. K. E. Society, in his presidential remarks, emphasized on the prudent use of the available energy depending upon one's need. 
The first technical session was addressed by Mr. Sameer Kanabargi from Phoenix Products, Belagavi who spoke on 'Biomass Energy for All Seasons'. Later in the second technical session, Mr. K. R. Mohanram, Scientific Officer- G, from the Nuclear Power Corporation of India Ltd., Kaiga explained the need to go in for 'Nuclear energy- A Clean Energy' so as to supplement the present need of energy for the development of our nation.


Followed by this talk, there was the paper presentation by the delegates. In all, 8 faculty and 11 student papers were presented in two separate sessions. Dr. Bhaskar Joshi, an eminent researcher was the Chairman for both the sessions. He gave a highly motivating, research oriented account of the fuel cells and future prospects. This was followed by the last technical session on 'Me and Energy Crisis' by Shri S. Y. Prabhu, the former Principal of G. S. S. College. He emphasized on the need to take care of mother earth and preserve its resources for the future.

- De-siltation of lakes, rivers, reservoirs etc., should be taken up by Government. Public participation, NGO's or NSS units' participation can be utilized.
- Dumping of dead bodies of people or animals in the rivers should be totally banned.
- Research on watershed development, water quality, recycling reuse, hydrology, environment ecology, biodiversity etc., need to be motivated and supported.
- Waste water management should be taken up as priority. Water purification filters should be installed in various parts for recycling the waste water. It is observed that the sewage water or polluted water from industries is directly let out in the drainage streams which pollute the drinking water resources.
- Wherever feasible linking of rivers can be undertaken.

Day One (21st January 2018)


The registration with breakfast for the delegates started at 9.00 AM. The inaugural session of the workshop was held at 10.30 AM with an invocation song from B.Sc final year students. Principal Dr N. D. Hegade welcomed the guests, invitees and the gathering. Dr. P. T. Hanamgond, Organising Secretary of the seminar briefed about the seminar. This was followed by introduction and felicitation of the guests. At the outset, guest of honour Sanjyot Bandekar, Mayor of Belagavi city appreciated the college for conducting the seminar on social importance and creating awareness regarding waste management; and she also appreciated to have included the city corporation corporators and officials in the seminar. The Chief Guest of the function Shri Ramdas Kokare, CEO Nagar Parishad, Karjat, Maharashtra, highlighted the importance of waste management and how he has created awareness among the society in Vengurla, which is well known as 'Vengurla pattern' for achieving the zero waste management status. Shri S. V. Shanbhag Vice Chairman, SKE Society, in his presidential remarks appreciated the organising committee for organising such an important seminar and appealed the audience to take home the learning from the seminar to create public awareness in maintaining our surrounding clean. Prof. (Mrs) S.S. Joshi presented the vote of thanks.

Key note address by the Chief Guest Shri Ramdas Kokare:

Shri Ramdas Kokare Chief Officer of Karjat Nagar Parishad delivered his talk on "Waste management with vengurla pattern for zero waste management". He was instrumental in making B&M model work for zero waste management in vengurla city. He began with a saying "mixed waste is a problem but segregated waste is a wealth". He focussed on strategies that he had implemented in managing the waste and results obtained in his 3 years of efforts. The main strategies are zero tolerance for zero waste, plastic bags were banned, reuse of plastic, collection of waste in segregated manner, installation of GPS trackers on solid waste collecting vehicles to ensure 100% Door to Door collection, preventing open defecation in city by forming Good Morning Pathak (walk). Strict actions were taken against people found using plastic bags and not segregating the waste. He organized various competitions at school level to create awareness. Dry waste is used as briquettes for fuel, wet waste used in biogas plant for generation of electricity & compost. Plastic material was recycled to obtain bitumen which is used to lay roads, and prepared 7 roads of 15km in Vengurla. He concluded his session with "This city is mine and yours together let's make it shine."

Session I: Dr. J. R. Mudakavi

Dr. J. R. Mudakavi, Director, Ana lab associates, II Sc Bangalore delivered a talk on "E-Waste management" He highlighted the ill effects of unscientific disposal of metallic waste and electronic waste into soil and water. The causes of increased generation of e-waste and the harmful effects of heavy metals on ecosystem.

He discussed about various innovative methods he has implemented such as elemental analysis kit for 53 metals, pilot plant E-Parisara for metal waste disposal, respiratory mask, and gold recovery technique from mobile batteries.

Session II: Dr. Priyadarshini Karve

Dr. Priyadarshini Karve, Director Samuchit Enviro Tech., gave a talk on "Becoming Carbon Negative through Biomass Waste" she talked about connection between sustain ability and lifestyle. Her talk focussed on use of biofuel, practice of microscale organic waste management. Effect of population explosion and consequent exploitation of natural resources and exhaustion of fossil fuels.

She explained about number of devices she has invented like improved biomass burning devices to reduce smoke in kitchen, technology for converting agriculture and garden waste into renewable charcoal. According to her 1kg of garden waste is equal to 100 Rs. Use of charcoal bags as odour absorbents. Charcoal can also be used to increase the water holding capacity of soil.

Session III: Dr Shubhada Nayak

Dr Shubhada Nayak, Vice-Principal, Karmveer Bhaorao Patil College, Vashi, Navi Mumbai delivered a talk on "SWM :Options and Opportunities in India". She explained the current scenario of industrial cities and metros in managing solid waste management, Hierarchy of sustainable waste management, practices of sustainable waste management, hazardous effects of unsanitary methods of waste management methods. She also dragged the attention towards the socio-economic problems associated with dumping grounds in metro cities.

Day 2 (22nd January 2018)

Session VI: Shri Gopal Santangi

Shri Gopal Santangi, Environmental officer board regional office, Belagavi spoke on "Industrial Effluent Treatment". He focused on the importance and quality of water, various causes of decreasing the quality of potable water. He also discussed about various parameters of potable water, methods of effluent water treatment & recycling of water. He said a small battery can pollute 60,000 litres of water.


Paper Presentation and Demonstration session

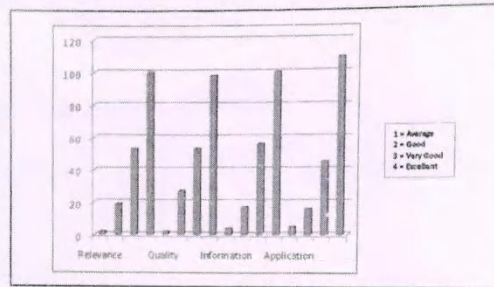
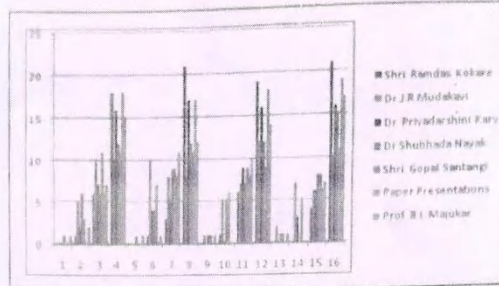
Panel Discussion and Valedictory
